



Building for the Future: The First National Bank of Central Texas Opens Flagship College Station Banking Center

The First National Bank of Central Texas officially opened its new College Station banking center in March 2026, marking a major milestone in the bank's expansion across Central Texas. Founded in 1901, the bank has more than 125 years of history and has grown into a leading independent community bank with approximately \$1.7 billion in assets.

The bank first entered the Bryan-College Station market in 2021 and operated from a temporary location while planning a permanent facility. On October 31, 2024, the bank held a groundbreaking ceremony for its new banking center at 4270 State Highway 6 South. The completed facility officially opened in March 2026 and serves as the bank's flagship location in the region.



At approximately 21,000 square feet, the state-of-the-art building was designed to support long-term growth and provide a full range of personal, business, mortgage, and commercial banking services. The College Station market is led by Bobby Williamson, a longtime banking professional and local community leader.

The new banking center reflects the bank's commitment to investing in one of Texas' fastest-growing markets while maintaining its community banking philosophy. The project represents a significant strategic investment and positions the bank for continued growth throughout the Bryan-College Station region.
