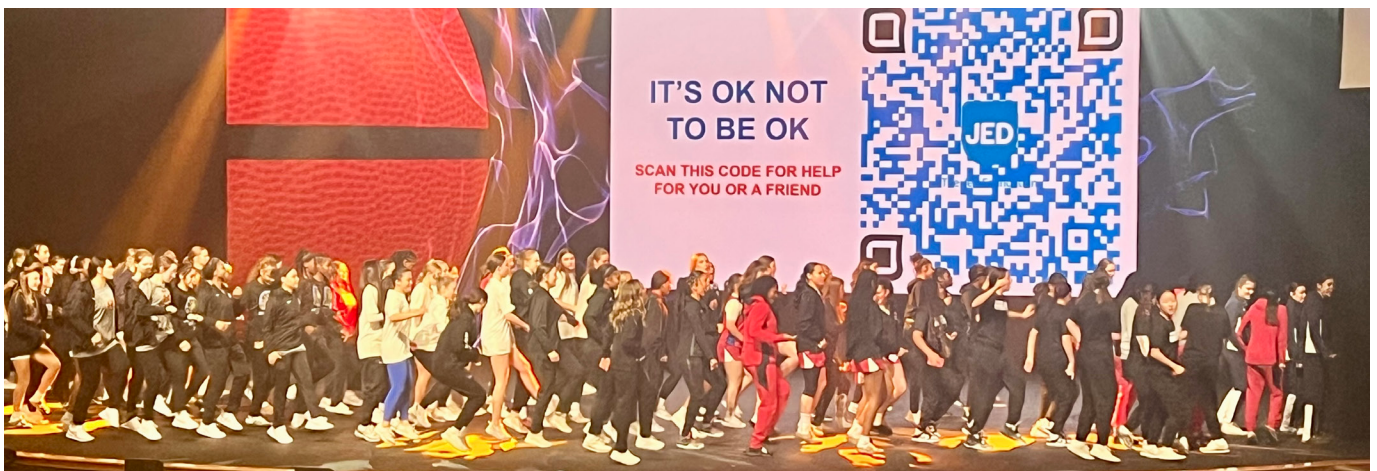


THE BEYOUTIFUL CLASSIC

Showing Up for Health and Hope

Our commitment to community service is just as deep in its South Texas communities as it is in Westlake. Nowhere is that more visible than in Carrizo Springs, where the team shows up for events that matter most to neighbors facing real hardship.

When Dimmit Regional Hospital hosted the **5K Pink Run** on October 4th in support of breast cancer awareness, the PrimeBank Carrizo Springs team was there running alongside survivors, current fighters, and the families and caregivers who walk beside them. Less than two weeks later, on October 18th, the team was back out before dawn for the **Walk Against Cancer**, joining the community for one of Carrizo Springs' most meaningful annual gatherings. Every mile walked by the PrimeBank team was a mile walked beside a neighbor.

When Dimmit Regional Hospital brought **Trunk or Treat** to Carrizo Springs for Halloween, PrimeBank was there too — joining families, dancing with DJ E-li, and being the kind of neighbor that shows up with candy and a smile for no reason other than it matters. Showing Up for Health and Hope

That same spirit of showing up is seen at the Dimmit County Annual **Back-to-School Health Fair**, where PrimeBank met families at the start of something new — handing out piggy banks and pencil cases alongside free school supplies and community resources. This annual gesture has a longer intention: helping kids build smart financial habits from the very beginning.

For four years running, PrimeBank has hosted **Customer Appreciation Cookouts** in both Carrizo Springs and Crystal City — two days, two communities, and over 1,200 hamburgers served. What started as a simple thank-you has become one of the most anticipated events of the year, a reminder that banking is a relationship business, and relationships are built face to face, over good food and genuine conversation. Events like these are a reminder of why we're proud to call Carrizo Springs home.

That commitment runs even deeper when it comes to the next generation. PrimeBank made a \$3,000 donation to the **Dimmit County Livestock Show**, with proceeds flowing directly into the DCJLSA Scholarship Fund — an investment in the hard-working young people of the county who are earning their futures one show at a time. PrimeBank awards **scholarships to students in Carrizo Springs and Crystal City**. In 2025, PrimeBank invested over \$2500 in the futures of five students in communities where access to higher education can be the deciding factor in a life's trajectory.
